

EMCS – COVID-19 Prevention Policy

Premise

Policy applies to any EMCS International Limited (EMCS) employee on a permanent or short-term contract who is engaged on a project on EMCS behalf (at a client site or on board a vessel), or for any person attending an EMCS office/site, in order to look to limit the exposure to and spread of Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) “COVID-19”.

Updates to Policy

EMCS continually monitor the requirements and recommendations of the World Health Organisation (WHO) regarding the situation per country and prevention of spreading of COVID-19

Requirements are also subject to advice taken locally from country of origin of worker, per country of attendance, of airlines and/or any countries that workers transit traveling to the place of work and any client site or vessel (manager/owner) requirements.

EMCS Sites

As well as following the local requirements per site/office, anyone attending an EMCS place of business is to follow the recommendations and requirements of the World Health Organisation “Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) advice for the public”:

EMCS Workers at Client Sites/Vessels (and in transit)

All EMCS workers undergo pre-travel COVID-19 PCR testing in order to obtain a ‘Fit to Travel’ Certificate as a requirement by some airlines, countries/ports and for health and safety of EMCS team and Ship’s crew. EMCS will be happy to complete any forms or details as required by Client Site/Vessel/Owner/Manager as part of their COVID-19 prevention policy.

EMCS workers on mobilisation, will be issued with sufficient “COVID-19 Prevention PPE” (facemasks, disposable gloves and hand sanitiser – at least 60% ethanol based), for travel and any time expected to be in standby or in transit, to client site or vessel.

Workers advised on mobilisation in their pre-joining instructions of latest WHO advice and requirements for travel.
